

## Camping at Atlantic Reach

For all campers safety, enjoyment and to ensure we comply with all relevant regulations regarding our campsite, please adhere to the following.

Please also remember we, your camping team, are here to help.



Arrival times are between 15:00 and 19:00. All vehicles including caravans and tourers must be accompanied at all times. (It is not possible to unhitch and leave your caravan for example.) Departure is no later than 11:00 please.



We ask you to drive very slowly on the campsite. There is a 15 mph speed limit on the main site, however you will understand that the slower the better on the campsite for everyone's safety.



All our pitches have an electric supply, please ensure you bring an electric hook up cable with you (minimum length 15m). The use of electric socket splitters is not permitted on site.



Pitching instructions will be provided and explained on arrival. It is very important that you ensure you follow these instructions as they are the basis for our fire safety and camping licence. We are on hand for any questions, the last thing we all want is for you to have to 're-pitch' once you've set up. Please check if you are unclear.



Each pitch has space for 1 car. If you are bringing an extra vehicle there will be a charge of £5 per day. The vehicle will need to be registered with reception and parked in our overflow parking areas please (our wardens will help you with this).



We do not accept sign written commercial vehicles on site.



There is a maximum of 2 dogs per pitch (extra charges apply). Please clean up after your dogs (there are a number of doggy waste bins around the site) and dogs must be kept on leads at all times.



Every booking includes a full Leisure Club pass which is valid for the duration of your stay (from 15:00 on day of arrival to 11:00 day of departure) All pool usage needs to be booked online at [www.atlanticreach.co.uk/cornwall-leisure-club/swimming](http://www.atlanticreach.co.uk/cornwall-leisure-club/swimming). Please do not expect to use the pool without booking a slot online. It is essential that you have your leisure pass with you when you go to the leisure club in order to access the pool area.



BBQs are permitted, but must be raised off the ground, no fires or fire pits of any type are permitted please.



Please advise the camping team on 07900 172650 stating your name and pitch number if you are expecting any visitors who are not staying on site. Please note all visitors must park their vehicles in the main car park and should not take them onto the campsite.



We are a quiet site between 22:30 and 08:00 (please, no music or loud noises during these times) - please respect your fellow campers. The entrance and exit gates to the campsite will be locked during these times. If you need to leave or return to site between 22:30 and 08:00 please leave your vehicle in one of the main car parks.
