



# Pitching Guidelines



## Check-In:

Check-in is between 15:00 and 19:00.

If you arrive early, please stay with your vehicle in The Arrivals/The Hut area. When your pitch is ready, one of our camping stewards will check you in and pitch you. Please do not un-hitch or leave the site until you've been pitched.



## Speed Limit:

For everyone's safety, the speed limit on site is 15 mph.



## Electric Hook-Up:

All pitches include an electric supply.

Please bring a cable of at least 25 metres in length.

Electric socket splitters are not permitted.



## Pitching Your Unit:

Our camping stewards will pitch you in line with the pitching instructions on the reverse of this document. If you're unsure, the stewards are always happy to help based on your specific setup.



## Vehicles:

Each pitch includes space for one car.

Extra vehicles are welcome at £5 per day and can be registered on arrival.

Additional vehicles must be parked in the main car park.

Please note, sign-written commercial vehicles are not permitted on site.



## Dogs:

We love dogs!

A maximum of 2 dogs per pitch. If you have forgotten to register your dog (s) at time of booking, please see our camping stewards to apply to your booking and pay the charge.

Dogs should be kept on a lead at all times please.



## BBQs and Fires:

You're welcome to use a raised BBQ at your pitch.

We have bricks available to borrow at The Hut if needed - just ask.

Fires and fire pits of any kind are not permitted.



## Visitors:

Visitors are welcome! Please notify the camping team in advance by calling 07733 830785.

Visitor vehicles must be parked in the main car park.



## Quiet Hours:

For the enjoyment of all guests, please keep noise to a minimum between 22:30 and 08:00 (No music during these hours, please).



## Gates:

The front gates are locked overnight.

If you plan to leave or return between 21:30 and 08:00, please use the gate near the main car park to access the camp site.



## Departure:

On your day of departure, please vacate your pitch by 11:00.

## Pitching Instructions

When you arrive, one of our team will explain how to pitch your caravan, camper, motorhome or tent correctly. We just ask that you follow their guidance, as it helps us meet safety requirements and keeps everything running smoothly.

If you're unsure about anything, please do check with us before setting up—it's much easier than having to re-pitch later! Thanks so much for your understanding, and we're here if you need us.



# KEEP CLEAR! FIRE BREAK

THE SPACE AT THE BACK OF THE PITCH WHERE 2 ROWS ARE BACK TO BACK



Minimum of 6 meters between these points



One per pitch

### HABITATION UNIT

- Caravan
- Camper
- Motorhome
- Tent

Guide ropes must be within pitch boundary

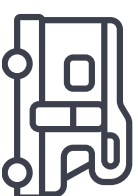
### AWNING / GAZEBO

- Not to be slept in

## YOUR PITCH



Minimum of 6 meters between these points



One per pitch
